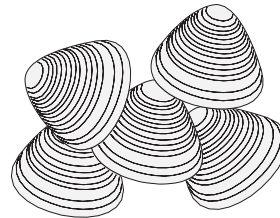

### **REAR COMMODORE'S REPORT**

Summer has finally arrived and I am sure you will all be out on the water and enjoying the Club as much as possible. By the time you read this, the new improved and enlarged swim platform will have been installed on our outer dock for your enjoyment.

Please remember that use of the BCC dock is for our members and their registered guests only. Overnight docking is permitted, but you must register with the Launch Service and you must stay on the boat overnight. If a guest is going to stay overnight, the member must pre-register the guest with the Launch Service and the Front Desk.

Please use common sense when choosing where to tie up. The outer portion of the floating docks is for keel boats and the inner portion is for power boats. The outermost T dock is for pick-ups/drop-offs only. Please obey the directions of the BCC staff. If you have a problem or a complaint, talk with a Director, or the senior BCC staff on duty - not the dingy shop/boat shop personnel. Remember

the boat shop is closed on weekends. There are no marina personnel on duty on Saturday or Sunday to assist with repair work, tools/materials or launching of boats.

If you still need a mooring, turn in your Mooring Form to the office and Enio will contact you with a mooring assignment.

Dry sail and beach boats must be registered with the office on proper forms with Enio. Kayaks must be registered in the office on proper forms with Bonnie.

Any boats on the Club side of Erie Road will be moved to the North lot in July. Summer storage fees will be assessed on July 15 in the North lot. If you choose to leave a boat trailer in the North lot this summer, understand it is at your own risk. Please inform Dave in the boat shop and make sure it is locked, and your name clearly visible on the trailer.

## BCC Cardboard Boat Regatta

**When:** August 17, 2008 at 1300 hours.

**The Challenge:** To build a human-powered cardboard boat capable of traveling approximately 150 yards without sinking.

**Rules:** All boats must be built of corrugated cardboard. No wood, plastic, or metal allowed. Waterproofing of your boat is acceptable with one-part waterproofing substances. A two part substance is any that requires the addition of a catalyst or hardner. This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes. Duct tape is allowed to reinforce stress points and seams. Your boat cannot be wrapped in duct tape.

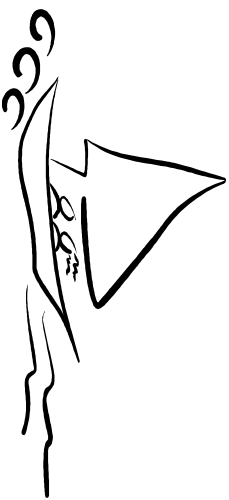
