

"The Burchfield Penney Art Center, accredited by the American Association of Museums, was founded in 1966 on the campus of Buffalo State College to honor the legacy of Charles E. Burchfield and the artists of Western New York State. The museum's collections include more than 7500 works by 700 WNY artists including the largest public collection of works by Charles E. Burchfield as well as the artist's archives and other archival materials.

In November 2008, the museum's first free-standing building opened to the public. The 84,000 square foot museum, designed by Gwathmey Siegel and Associates Architects of New York City is the first "green" art museum in New York State having earned silver LEED status from the U.S. Green Building Council. In January 2009, the travel editors of The New York Times named Buffalo, New York and the Burchfield Penney Art Center the #37 of 44 Places to Go in 2009."

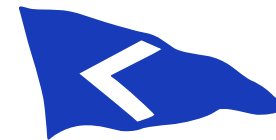
